Minnesota State Girls' Hockey Tournament Records that were established or tied in 2025

Records Established:

Most penalties by team in game:

Moorhead, in its game with Andover, was whistled for a record 13 penalties, eclipsing the record of 12 previously held by Andover when they played Minnetonka last season.

Most penalties by both teams in period:

In that same game, Andover and Moorhead had nine penalties in the second period, breaking the record of eight (previously achieved six times).

Most shots on goal by both both teams in an overtime period:

Orono (15) and Warroad (8) combined for 23 shots on goal in their second overtime period. This breaks the record of 22 which was shared by Lakeville North and Mounds View (in 2014) and Andover vs. Lakeville South in 2018.

Most goals scored while two players short in the penalty box in a game:

Holy Family scored a goal in their game against Centennial/Spring Lake Park during the second period while they were two players short in the penalty box. It is the first time ever in a girls state tournament game (it has only happened twice to the boys).

Records Tied:

Most penalties by team in period:

Moorhead had six penalties in the second period of their game with Andover, tying the record last year when Andover was whistled for six in the second period against Minnetonka.

Most penalties by both teams in game:

Andover and Moorhead had 19 penalties in their game. Last year, Andover and Minnetonka also had 19.

Earliest penalty assessed in a game

Centennial/Spring Lake Park was called for a penalty just nine seconds into the game (tying the record held by South St. Paul against Rochester Lourdes in 2020).

Fewest penalties by both teams in game:

In the Dodge County vs. Warroad game, there were no penalties assessed. Only the fourth time a girls game was played without a stoppage for a penalty (most recently by Eastview and Stillwater in 2021). The Dodge County vs. Warroad game was the first ever championship game without a penalty.

Fewest shots on goal by team in period:

Moorhead, in the first period of their game with Holy Family, had no shots on goal, tying the record held with sixteen other teams, most recently by Rosemount (vs. Andover, third period) in 2024.

Jottings:

Warroad ended its state tournament 11-game winning streak when they lost to Dodge County in the Class A championship game. This tied Edina (2017-2019) for the second longest win streak ever. That honor goes to Breck (13 games from 2011-2020).

Dodge County became the first southern Minnesota girls hockey team to win a state championship.

Coach David Marvin of Warroad has now coached 15 teams in the state tournament and won a record 34 games. Only South St. Paul's Dave Palmquist has coached in more state tournaments (17)

Leading scorer for the "A" tournament was Zoe Lopez from Orono (6 goals, 4 assists) and Hill-Murray's Emily Pohl topped all other "AA" teams with 5 goals and 3 assists.

Of the 32 officials that worked the tournament this year, nine of them were first timers to the state tournament.
