

Minnesota State Girls' Hockey Tournament Highlights in 2026

Record Tied:

Most overtime games played in a tournament:

Dodge County played in two overtime games this tournament. This tied the mark held by 13 other schools, most recent by Warroad in 2025.

Jottings:

Hill-Murray won their fourth state title, winning it in back-to-back seasons.

Breck won its fifth title ever, the Mustangs first since winning three in a row in 2018-2020. They also won in 2012.

The two state champs had only five seniors on their rosters (Hill-Murray only had two)! Don't be surprised to see them again next year.

St. Cloud was the first newcomer to the state tournament this year.

Warroad appeared in its 17th state tournament, tying South St. Paul for the most state tournament appearances. Coach David Marvin of Warroad has now coached 16 teams in the state tournament and won a record 36 games. Only South St. Paul's Dave Palmquist has coached in more state tournaments (17)

Leading scorer for the "A" tournament was Warroad's Jaylie French with four goals and six assists and ten points. Farmington's Jenna Goblirsch and Taylor Risch topped the "AA" list, both with three goals and four assists for a total of seven points.

Of the 31 officials that worked the tournament this year, nine of them were first timers to the state tournament.
